### 29) Mon – March 18 – SIN NO MORE

Now is the time to change whatever draws you away from godly ways (John 8:11)

### 30) Tues - March 19 – ACCEPT JESUS (ST JOSEPH’S)

Like Joseph, take Jesus into your home to be the center of your life.  
(Matthew 1:20)

### 31) Wed – March 20 – REMAIN IN MY WORD

Take time to quietly ponder Jesus’ words today.  
(John 8:31-32)

### 32) Thurs – March 21 – RECALL GOD’S WORKS

Praise and thank God today for the beauty of creation (Psalm 104:4-5)

### 33) Fri – March 22 – FAST FROM REVENGE (Abstinence from meat ages 14 - 59)

Put aside all desire to repay someone for any evil done to you. (John 10:31-32)
